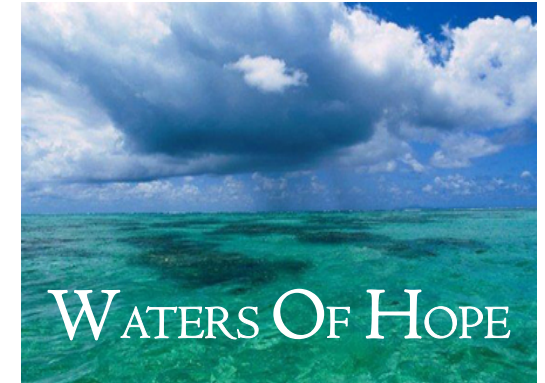


WHAT IS WATERS OF HOPE?

- Support the bike ride as it comes near or through your community



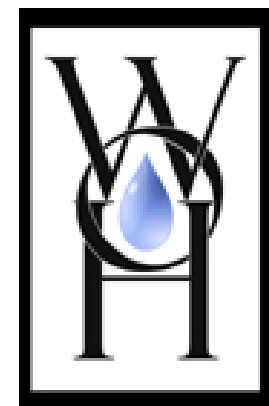

CLEAN WATER

Clean water is an absolute human right that more than a billion persons live without each and every day. Shockingly, 4,400 children under the age of 5 die each day from dirty drinking water that is infested with water-borne diseases (United Nations). And the Global Water has stated that "The lack of access to safe drinking water is the primary cause of disease and poverty in the world."



MILLENNIUM DEVELOPMENT GOALS

The benefits of clean water are too numerous to list, however clean water contributes directly to three of the Millennium Development Goals :

- #4 *Reduce Child Mortality*
- #5 *Improve Maternal Health*
- #6 *Combat HIV/AIDS, malaria and other diseases*

Medically, clean water can do more than vaccinations, antibiotics, and immunizations



combined. What good is an antibiotic, if a person repeatedly ingests internal parasites found in their water supply?
